What soever you bound on earth shall be bound in heaven and whatsoever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. The Church that Jesus has established in the earth has it all. All the revelation and all the information you need is in the Church. It is God that is the one that is doing the speaking and the teaching in the Church. Man had not anything to do with it. Jesus chose twelve men to preach the gospel to the world and they all preached Jesus. They didn't have two or three different names nor two or three different doctrines. The Apostles came in the name of the Lord Jesus. Even from the beginning of time it was always in the name of the Lord.

In the book of Genesis 22:14, Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh meaning the Lord provides. In

the book of Exodus 17:15, "And Moses built and altar. And called the name of it Jehovahnissi. Meaning the Lords Banner."

Judges 6:24 "Then Gideon built an altar there unto the Lord and called it Jehovahshalom meaning the Lord is peace. Unto this day it is yet in Ophrah of the Abiezrites."

Jesus came on the scene through twelve men to teach all nations teaching them to observe all things. And told them whatso ever I commanded you and lo I am with you all ways even until the end of the world. The Apostles understood what Jesus was saying because the scripture says in the book of Luke 24: 44. Pentecost is a celebration that everybody under the heaven came together to the celebration. The scriptures says in the book of Psalm 20:5. "We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all thy petitions". Greetings everyone, we greet you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

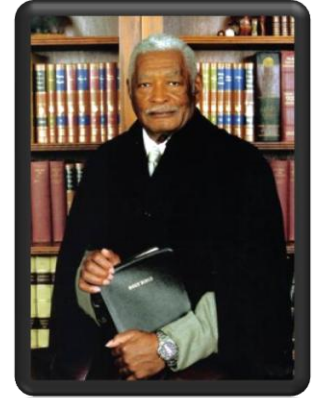

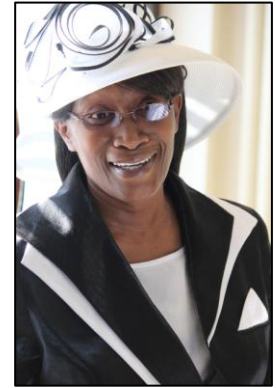


Sister Katryce Bush of Dallas, Texas writes:

With gladness day and night.

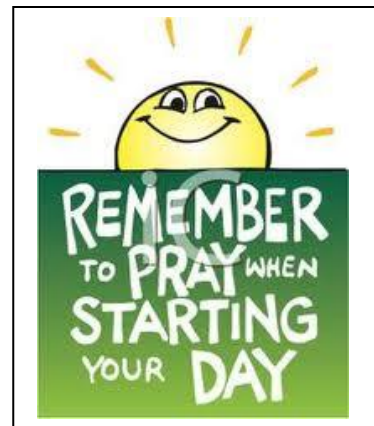
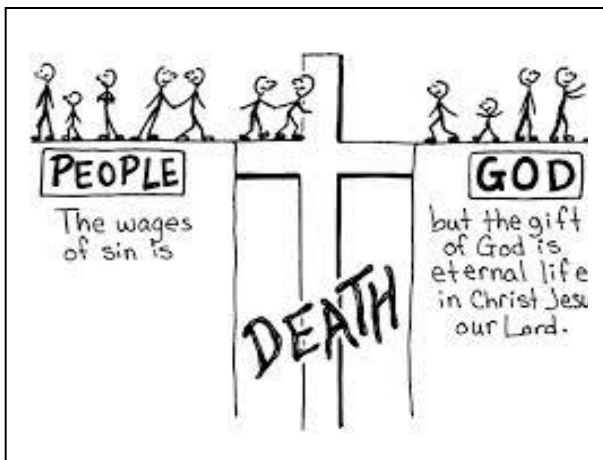
Their lives are nourished like a tree

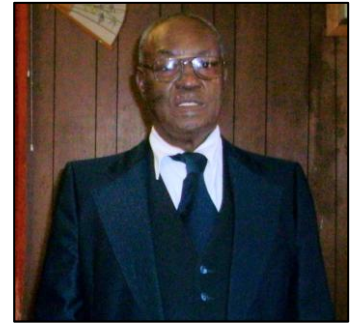
