Words from the Pastor The Church Knows the Truth

Greetings everyone, we greet you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Whether you believe it or not, you are responsible for the gospel that was preached by the apostles. The bible says in Matthew 28:20 *"Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen."* So that is why we tell you that you are responsible for the gospel that was preached by the apostles because that is the way it is. They put Jesus to death in the flesh.
